

Homework

Your child will be given homework activities which may not always require them to write or record.

Home Reading

It is really important that you listen to your child read at home at least 3 times per week and sign their reading diary to show that they have read.

Accelerated Reader

All children in school take a quiz on the computer to check their understanding of the book they have read. This will then track your child's reading progress.

As a parent, you can log in to the Accelerated Reader programme to check your child's progress.



Myon

Myon is our online reading scheme that links to Accelerated Reader. Children can log on at home and read from our collection of e-books before taking a quiz on Accelerated Reader.



At Moorpark we use Times Table Rockstars to help the children to learn their times tables. Each child will receive their access codes so they can battle against each other whilst still learning.

Information for parents.

Annual reports to parents will be sent out at the end of the summer term.

Should you wish to, you will be able to discuss the report with the class teacher, by appointment, either during the afternoon or evening sessions.


