### Homework

Your child will be given homework activities each week which will include spellings, times tables and either an English or a Maths focused activity.

### Myon/Times tables Rocks Stars

Your child will be given a login in their diary for Myon where they can read books online at home. They will also be given a login for times tables rocks stars. On this website they can practise their times tables in a fun and engaging way.

### Home Reading

It is really important that you listen to your child read at home at least three times a week and sign their reading diary.

### Accelerated Reader

All children in school take a quiz on the computer to check their understanding of the book they have read. This will then track your child's reading progress.

As a parent, you can log in to the Accelerated Reader programme to check your child's progress.



### Information for Parents.

### Start of Day
