AMAZING ARTIST CREATES MASSIVE MURAL IN HONOUR OF CAPTAIN SIR THOMAS MOORE

A large picture of Captain Sir Thomas Moore has been painted on a wall in the centre of Manchester.

The artist, Akse P19, painted the artwork in tribute to the 100 year old who died on the 2nd February 2021. Moore, an army veteran, raised almost £33m for NHS charities by completing 100 laps of his garden.

Now, you might think that this seems easy... but he was nearly 100 at the time and had to use a walker. However, that didn't stop him!

In July 2020, the Army veteran was knighted by the Queen in a special ceremony at Windsor Castle. This means that the Queen celebrated his achievements, and gave him an official title.

During the event, Moore said that it was "such a high award and to get it from Her Majesty as well - what more can anyone wish for? This has been an absolutely magnificent day for me."

Akse P19 is the artist behind this artwork and several other murals in the city, including a tribute to the brave NHS workers who worked throughout the pandemic.

He also created a mural of footballer Marcus Rashford who campaigned to extend free school meals during lockdown. Marcus has also teamed up with the publisher Macmillan Children, which will donate 50,000 books to schools across the UK.
