## PRINCE PHILIP HAS DIED, AGED 99.

With deep sorrow, The Royal Family announced the death of Prince Philip on the 9<sup>th</sup> April 2021. The Prince, who died peacefully at the age of 99, had been married to the Queen for an impressive 73 years!

Prince Philip was born in 1921, on the Greek Island of Corfu. His family were originally royals, but they were banished. This means that they had to leave the country forever and were no longer seen as their royal family. As you can imagine, this gave the family a bad reputation.

He then spent his childhood in France, Germany and the UK. In 1939, after leaving school, he joined the Royal Navy. During World War II, he continued to serve in the British Forces.



On the 20<sup>th</sup> November 1947, Prince Philip and the Queen married at Westminster Abbey in London. Their wedding cake was taller than Prince Philip, so there was definitely enough cake to go around! Prince Philip also got to cut the cake using a special sword, which was given to him by the Queen's father.

The Prince and Queen had four children together. Their names are Prince Charles, Princess Anne, Prince Andrew and Prince Edward. When the Queen dies, Prince Charles will be the king as he is the oldest child. At the moment, Prince Charles is 72!

Prince Philip was involved with many charities and was a patron to almost 800 organisations. This means that he would give money and raise awareness about organisations that needed help.
