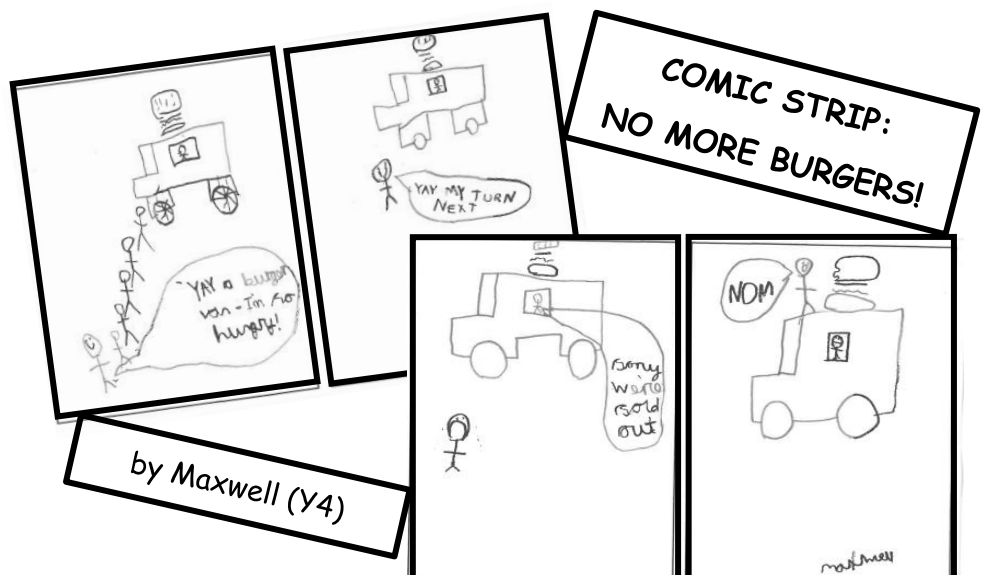
Q. What are your favourite historical time periods?

Dear Andy,

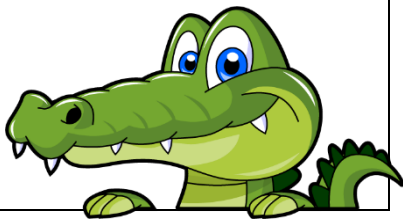
I am struggling in P.E. I'm not very fast and I am making my team loose. I don't want them to hate me. I am worried and sad.

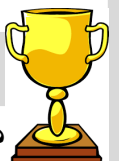
