



Dear Year 5 Parents

Bikeability sessions have been arranged at Moorpark Junior School for your child over **Wednesday 19th & Thursday 20th January 2022** – your child is offered the chance to take part in Bikeability training during these days. This is a national scheme, funded by the Department for Transport and the City of Stoke-on Trent Council.

Bikeability Level 2 (for pupils who can ride a bike/rides frequently at home) training enables every pupil to gain a real cycling experience so they can deal with traffic on short journeys such as cycling to friends. Participants will gain a comprehensive knowledge of positioning, signaling, negotiating a variety of junctions and most importantly road safety awareness.

Bikeability Level 1 (for pupils who can ride but may be wobbly/doesn't ride their bike often at home) a playground session is available to teach pupils cycle skills.

Learn2Ride (for pupils who are not able to ride their bike without stabilisers) a playground session is available to teach your child to ride their bike.

Participants should use their own maintained bike if they have one (we strongly recommend a helmet) or if not, can borrow a bike/helmet from CTL, signed parental consent and suitable outdoor clothing. Parental permission must be given if no helmet is being worn*.

Parents/Carers **must complete the consent below & return to school before Tuesday 7th December 2021.**
