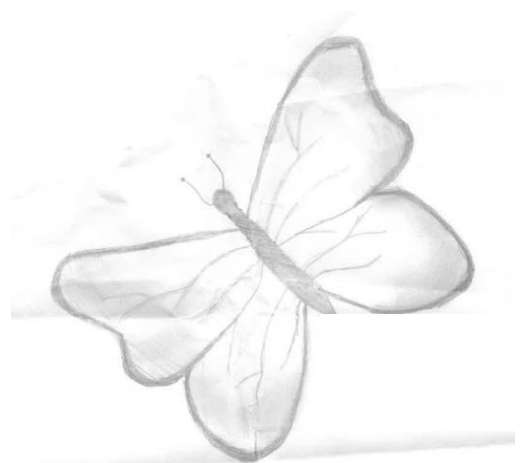
We had so many amazing designs! We had everything from super scientists, actors, gardeners and even palaeontologists!

They all looked so amazing and creative! We cannot wait to see who wins!



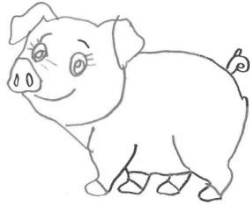

Which is your favorite team out of the two?

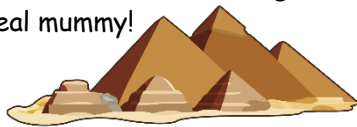
