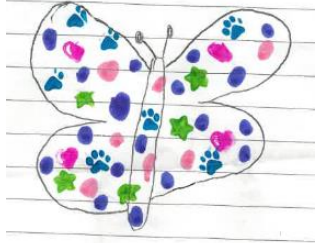

SPORT FACTS

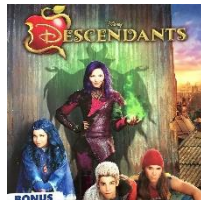
- There are over 8000 different types of sports.
