As you are aware we have a strong school policy on uniform and this does include the PE uniform for the PE lessons. It has become noticeable that some children are not wearing the correct PE uniform or sometimes not coming in it on their PE day. Below I have set out the PE days for you, as a reminder and a list of kit that is required.

Year group	Day
3	Tuesday
4	Wednesday
5	Thursday
6	Friday

PE kit required:

- Black or blue jogging bottoms or shorts
- White plain t-shirt/or red polo t shirt (no logos please)
- Blue/black plain jumper (no logos please) – a school jumper is also fine.
- Trainers/pumps

Any child with long hair needs to have it tied up please as is in line with school uniform policy. A reminder that no jewellery should be worn at any time in school – just a watch is allowed if needed.

It is essential that all children take part in PE. It is an essential part of our school curriculum and provides so many opportunities for the children to develop their team skills and resilience in trying new activities. The health benefits are endless too as we all look forward to improving our own health and well-being.

If your child forgets their PE kit on their PE day, they will be offered spare kit that we have in school. Children will not be allowed to do PE in their normal school uniform. The children need to wear comfortable clothing for PE.
