



Dear parents/carers,

We are looking forward and are excited for the start of the new school year in September. We already have so many exciting things planned for you and can't wait for you to return to school to enjoy them.

All the pupils return to school on **Wednesday 2nd September, 2026**

Start and end of day times

The doors to school will open at **8.45am** for **ALL pupils** and this will provide a flexible start to the day. All children will need to be in school by **8.55am** as **this is when registration closes and after this your child will be marked as late**. Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time as this is really important. If your child is late you **MUST** sign them in using the screen in the entrance. Children must be signed in by an adult.

The school day will **end at 3.10pm** for **ALL pupils**. **Only year 6 pupils will be able to walk home without an adult and of course, with parental consent which will be obtained through a letter in September.**

The information you will need for each year group is on the table below.

Year group	Entrance/exit	PE days (children to wear PE kit)
3	2N/3P – Enter - small blue door bottom of playground. Exit – fire exit from hall. 2C/3B – Entrance and exit - small blue door bottom of playground.	Tuesday
4	Double blue doors by bike shelter	Thursday
5	Top blue doors by gym equipment	Wednesday
6	Bottom door on playground	Friday

N.B. sometimes we have to change the PE days, you will always be notified of this in advance.

All the staff are eager to get to know their new classes and share their new, exciting topics with them. Look out for our launch days when the children get to dress up and really immerse themselves in their new topic. We will be inviting parents into school to watch our fabulous class assemblies very soon! Keep an eye out on class dojo and your texts for this!

Water bottles and book bags

Unfortunately this year we are unable to purchase water bottles for the children so we invite them to bring one in from home. Please can you ensure that your child has their name on their water bottle. We have limited space in our cloakrooms/classrooms so we ask that children do NOT bring rucksacks to school. They only need to bring their reading book and diary which will fit into a book bag and their lunch bag if needed. School will provide all the other equipment that your child needs.

Uniform

Polite reminder that we do have a uniform policy that we expect everyone to follow. Children are not allowed to wear trainers on non PE days (unless they are completely black with no other colours). Children are not allowed to wear hoodies in school, if needed they must wear a blue jumper as the policy states. For PE, children are not allowed to wear football shirts or tracksuits with logos on. Let's work together to ensure our children look smart every day in school. School policy states that **earrings cannot be worn in school at any time**. If your child has their ears pierced then we recommend that they wear the plastic retainers.

Watch me learn

Watch out for the flyers for 'Watch me Learn' where parents/carers are invited into school to join their child in a lesson and experience first-hand a part of your child's school day. We have found these to be highly successful in the past and look forward to continuing this next year. 😊
