



Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of our topic in History, Year 5 are going to embark on an educational visit to the **Hanley Potteries Museum**. During our visit the children will learn how Reginald Mitchell became an aircraft designer and find out about his journey to designing the Spitfire and why the Spitfire was important in our history and explore its contribution to the Battle of Britain.

The visit will take place on **Tuesday, 14th July, 2026** and we will be leaving school promptly at 9:30am (Children to be on the yard for **9:15am**). We anticipate arriving back at school at **3:10pm**. We will be travelling by Minibus.

All children will need to be in full school uniform and wearing comfortable footwear.

A £3 goody bag is available to purchase but must be ordered 3 weeks before so please bring this in and hand it to your child's class teacher by **Tuesday 23rd June 2026**.

Payment

However, the school governors have agreed funding educational visits each half term and the cost of parental contributions will be **£8 per half term** to be paid for by **ParentPay**. There is an option to pay in £2.00 instalments or the £8.00 in full, see ParentPay for details. **If ALL parents do not pay the £8 contribution the trip will NOT be able to go ahead and will have to be cancelled.**

Parental Consent *Via ParentPay*

To give permission for your child to go on this trip you will need to log on to ParentPay, find your child's account and the correct trip under payment items then follow the instructions ticking the relevant boxes. We cannot accept verbal permission therefore if you do not complete this your child will not be able to go on this trip.

If your child requires a packed lunch from school, please indicate what your child would like as you pay for the trip on **ParentPay** and pay as you usual would (if not on free school meals). Please provide your child with a drink as one will not be provided with their lunch.

Please ensure that **any medication** that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and dosage requirements and that the teachers are aware that your child has the medication with them.
