



Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of our geography topic, Year 3 are going to embark on an educational visit to **Blackpool**. During our visit the children will learn about the differences between Stoke-on-Trent and Blackpool.

The visit will take place on **Monday, 15th June, 2026** and we will be leaving school promptly at **8:30am** (Children to be on the yard for **8:15am**). We anticipate arriving back at school **traffic depending** at approximately **4:30pm** and we will be travelling by coach.

All children will need to be in P.E kits with their school jumper and wearing comfortable footwear.

We would also advise that the children bring:

- sun cream
- hat
- small towel
- lightweight jacket

If your child requires a packed lunch from school, please indicate on the form below and pay for this as you usually would (if not on free school meals). Please provide your child with a drink as one will not be provided with their lunch.

Activities

During our visit, we will also be doing the following activities; Donkey ride, Bouncy castle and an ice cream. For your child to participate in these activities we will require **£10 (additional to the £8 trip cost)** therefore they do not require further spending money.

To secure your child's place on the activities please can you ensure that the **£10 activity money** is brought into school by **Friday, 5th June 2026**, in a named envelope. If you do not pay the £10 activity money by this date, your child will not be able to take part in the activities.

Payment for the trip

Admission cost is £0 + Transport cost is £695 = The total cost of this trip to school is £695 (Actual cost per child £11.58).

However, the school governors have agreed funding educational visits each half term and the cost of parental contributions will be **£8 per half term** to be paid for by **ParentPay**, therefore we are subsidising this trip by **£3.58 per pupil**. There is an option to pay in £2.00 instalments or the £8.00 in full, see ParentPay for details.

As you can see school are contributing towards the trip so if ALL parents do not pay the £8 contribution the trip will NOT be able to go ahead and will have to be cancelled.

Please ensure that **any medication** that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and dosage requirements and that the teachers are aware that your child has the medication with them.

Please complete and return the form on the second page. We cannot accept verbal permission therefore if you do not return the form your child will not be able to attend the visit.
