



Dear Parent/ Carer,

In previous years, as part of our outdoor education curriculum year 6 have attended a residential at Stanley Head outdoor education centre. This year for a variety of reasons we are unable to do this. However, as we do not want the children to miss out on this part of their education year 6 we will be doing several day visits across the year. During their visits the children will be taking part in various team building and outside adventurous activities such as axe throwing, rifle shooting and canoeing.

The visit will take place on **Thursday, 19th October, 2023** and we will be leaving school promptly at 9:30am (Children need to be in for the start of the school day, doors open at **8:45am**). We anticipate arriving back at school at **4:00pm**. We will be travelling by bus, Stanley Head's transport. **Due to us arriving back after school time, ALL children must be collected by an adult.**

All children will need to wear old warm clothes such as a tracksuit that they don't mind getting dirty and are comfortable in, a waterproof coat and suitable footwear. The teachers will advise on what footwear will be needed depending on the activities the children will be taking part in.

If your child requires a packed lunch from school please indicate on the form below. Therefore, if you pay for school dinners please ensure that you pay the usual £2.86 a meal onto your child's ParentPay account or alternatively pay £14.30 for the week.

The school governors have agreed funding educational visits each half term and the cost of parental contributions will be **£8 per half term**. The trip will also need to be paid for via Parentpay. If you would prefer to pay by cash (via Paypoint) then please take the barcode at the bottom of this letter to your nearest outlet to make the payment. **Please note this barcode is for this trip only, a different barcode is provided for every payment item i.e. each trip which is unique to your child's account.**

Please ensure that **any medication** that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and dosage requirements and that the teachers are aware that your child has the medication with them.
