IF YOU COULD BE...

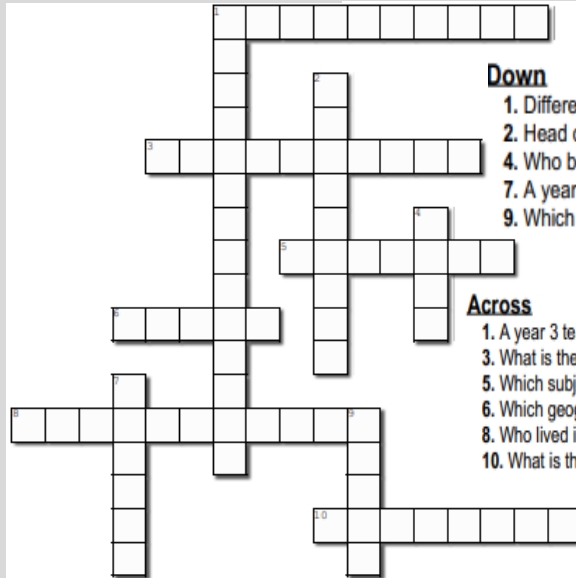

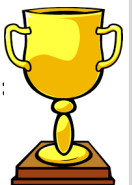
