Bikeability cycle training has been arranged at your school over **Monday 28th & Tuesday 29th November 2022**. Cyclist Training Ltd coaches young people in vital skills that stay with them for life.

Bikeability Level 1 (for pupils who can ride but doesn't ride their bike often at home) on the school playground we children how to **maintain their cycle, glide and control their bike**: including setting off, cruising, pedalling, slowing down, braking and stopping.

Learn2Ride (for pupils who cannot ride their bike without stabilisers) a playground session is available to teach your child to ride their bike.

This is a **FREE** national scheme funded by the Department for Transport and provided through Stoke on Trent City Council. Participants will receive a certificate and badge.

Participants should use their own roadworthy bike if they have one (we strongly recommend a helmet), signed parental consent and outdoor clothing (gloves) or sunblock subject to conditions. Parental permission must be given if no helmet is being worn*. **CTL can loan a bike/helmet if required – please indicate below.**

Parents/Carers **must complete the slip below and return to school before Tuesday 8th November.**
