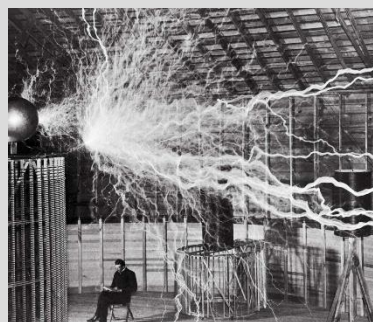

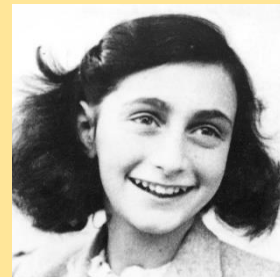


STUDENT WRITTEN WORK
