
Moorpark Junior Science Fair 2023



Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to announce that, as part of this year's Science Week, we will be hosting a science fair. The children have all been invited to participate by doing a science project, either by themselves or with a friend.

The project can be an experiment to answer a question, a problem and solution or a research project. It can be on any area of science that interests your child. For example, questions could be 'How many stars can we see?', 'Do plants need light to grow?' or 'How does a hovercraft work?'



When your child has carried out their investigation or research, they have to make a display board to communicate their learning to others. This can be presented in any way the children like, but an example is shown in the picture presented.

This display board should show the project title/question/problem, what your child thinks the answer is, what they did, what they found and a conclusion. If they want, they can include a small model or experiment.

All projects need to be in school in school by **Friday 10th March and our School Science Fair will take place on Friday 17th March, 3pm-3:30pm.** Parents and carers are welcome to join us! A panel of judges will help to choose the best projects and there will be some prizes up for grabs! Yours faithfully,
