Start and end of day times for September 2023

The doors to school will open at **8.45am** for **ALL pupils** and this will provide a flexible start to the day. All children will need to be in school by **8.55am** as this is when registration closes and after this your child will be marked as late. Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time as this is really important.

The school day will end at 3.10pm for ALL pupils. Only year 6 pupils will be able to walk home without an adult and of course, with parental consent which will be obtained through a letter in September.
