Even more so, we were able to meet and interview Conor Ripley and Jayson Leutwiler, who are the goal keepers for the Port Vale team. Read on to find out what these two players had to say!



Q. How did you first get introduced to football?

Ripley: I followed in my dad's footsteps, and was influenced by his love of the game.

Leutwiler: My uncle played, and I was inspired by him to become a role model for others.

Q. What was your favourite subject in school and why?

Ripley: I enjoyed art. I loved drawing. I moved to Switzerland when I was young and had an art scholarship. If I wasn't a football player, I would definitely have loved to be an artist.

Leutwiler: I really enjoy logical things, and found that maths was easy. French and English, I was just terrible at.

Q. Who are your heroes, both on and off the pitch?

Leutwiler: Each other! We have been friends for 13 years.

Ripley: I was born in Middlesbrough and played there. Jayson came from Switzerland and could barely speak a word of English.

Leutwiler: We moved in together, and we helped each other to learn each other's language. We are best friends.

Ripley: He was the best man at my wedding.

Q. What has been the biggest challenge that you have faced in your career?

<u>Leutwiler:</u> When I was in my early 20s and living and playing in Switzerland, I was worried that I wouldn't be able to pursue a career in football as it isn't as big in Switzerland as it is here. Thankfully, I was given an opportunity to move to England.

<u>Ripley:</u> For me, it was when I was injured and then couldn't play for four years. My career was put at risk because I couldn't play or train. I needed to be mentally strong during this time.
