



Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of our topic on the Stone Age to the Iron Age. Year 3 are going to embark on an educational visit to **The Shropshire Hills Discovery Centre.** During our visit the children will learn about Stone Age life and handle artefacts from the past.

The visit will take place on **Monday 20th October 2025** and we will be leaving school promptly at 8:30am (Children to be on the yard for **8:15am**). We anticipate arriving back at school at 4pm. We will be travelling by coach.

All children will need to be in full school uniform and wearing comfortable footwear.

Payment

Admission cost is £331.20 + Transport cost is £685 = The total cost of this trip to school is £1,016.20 (Actual cost per child £16.93).

However, the school governors have agreed funding educational visits each half term and the cost of parental contributions will be £8 per half term to be paid for by ParentPay, therefore we are subsidising this trip by £8.93 per pupil. There is an option to pay in £2.00 instalments or the £8.00 in full, see ParentPay for details.

As you can see school are heavily contributing towards the trip so if ALL parents do not pay the £8 contribution the trip will NOT be able to go ahead and will have to be cancelled.

Parental Consent **new system on parent pay*

To give permission for your child to go on this trip you will need to log on to ParentPay, find your child's account and the correct trip under payment items then follow the instructions ticking the relevant boxes. We cannot accept verbal permission therefore if you do not complete this your child will not be able to go on this trip.

If your child requires a packed lunch from school, please indicate what your child would like, as you pay for the trip on **ParentPay** and pay for this as you usually would (if not on free school meals). Please provide your child with a drink as one will not be provided with their lunch.

Please ensure that **any medication** that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and dosage requirements and that the teachers are aware that your child has the medication with them.
